# Pastor's Message / Mensaje del Párroco



As I am reading over these readings for this Sunday, Paul says to the Corinthians in our second reading that “the love of Christ impels us.” I must admit that I remember this phrase from the movie, “The Exorcist.” The power (love) of Christ impels us. With that short phrase the priests cast out the power of Satan that has taken hold of the young girl, Regan. The power of Christ impels us, too, though not like the priests in the Exorcist. The love of Christ impels us to love God above all things. It sounds easy, but it is not easy to accomplish. Do we love God more than ourselves or our family or our friends or our job or possessions? Any created thing will do battle with us to win our devotion, but we always are called to put Christ first. We pray that we can put Christ first so that we can always do God’s will in every moment. But this does not mean that we are isolated or cut off from people. In the context of our lives in which we encounter many other brothers and sisters, we ask the Lord to let the love of Christ impel us each day. Are there people we do not love as we should? Are there people against whom we have resentments or grudges? Are there people we have wronged or have wronged us? We pray for a spirit of forgiveness, allowing that love of Christ to inspire us to love more in harmony with others. The love of Christ suppresses evil and causes us to treat others as the sons and daughters of a loving God.

Cualquiera cosa terrenal trata de ganar nuestra devoción, pero siempre estamos llamados poner al Cristo primero. Pedimos que recibamos la fuerza poner Jesús primero en nuestras vidas, pero no significa que estamos aislados de los demás. Cada Día encontramos a muchos Hermanos y hermanas y pedimos que el amor de Dios nos urge amarlos a ellos. ¿Hay personas que no amamos como deberíamos amar? ¿Tenemos resentimientos o coraje contra una persona? ¿Hemos ofendido a una persona o una persona nos ha ofendido? Pedimos un Espíritu de perdón, permitiendo que el amor de Cristo nos urge vivir en armonía con otros. El amor de Cristo nos urge eliminar lo malo y abrazar a todos como Hermanos en Cristo.

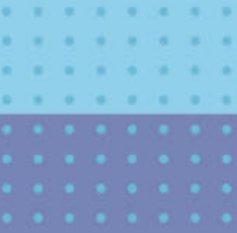

- I. Strengths (Good News)**
  - a. Quality candidates, stability with numbers of new seminarians over the past seven years, retention is strong
  - b. Growth with Hispanic vocations – 32% of seminarians
  - c. Projected new seminarians for 2024: one for St. John Vianney College Seminary, and 3 for the Spirituality Year
  - d. Growth in lay supporters
  - e. One candidate from Asian/Pacific Islander community and one candidate from the Black Catholic community
- II. Weaknesses (areas for growth)**
  - a. Overall number remains low: 31 seminarians
  - b. No candidates in 2024 from the Polish communities
- III. Opportunities**
  - a. Growth with candidates for college seminary
- IV. Threats**
  - a. Pace of life for priests and discerners
  - b. Fear of commitment for candidates
  - c. Lack of parental support, either for seminary or Totus Tuus
